Looking Ahead to 2021 Expanding Our Impact

While we hope to be able to safely visit care facilities sometime this year, we are prioritizing our online programming, especially our singalongs. Also, we are planning to produce our first magazine this year.

Virtual Singalongs

- We have already licensed 10 recordings and are planning additional Singalong Shows early in 2021.
- We have received a \$985 grant from The Pollination Project Foundation (thepollinationproject.org) in support of our virtual singalongs program.

Joyful Memories will be designed for families to share with loved ones who have Alzheimer's. Content will be timeless and intergenerational, featuring original and curated pictures, stories, poems, and jokes.

Each 24-page issue will focus on a specific theme (i.e. gardening, childhood, cats, dogs, summer, winter, woodworking, flowers).

- We will conduct a special fundraising campaign in support of the magazine, directed especially toward contacts in printing and publishing.
- An editorial team will produce three prototype issues to be used in fundraising efforts, hopefully allowing us to increase our initial print run and distribution.
